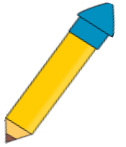

## Why are peer models needed for the classroom?

Peer models are needed to provide role models for other children in the classroom.



## What else do I need to know?

Your child must:

- Have age-appropriate language development.
- Have age-appropriate behavior development.
- Be toilet trained.
- Be 3 years old by May 1, 2022.
- Have consistent attendance (less than 10 absences for the school year).
- Be transported to and from school by parent/caregiver.

Snyder Elementary School is pleased to announce an opportunity for preschool children within our community to possibly attend a ½ day Early Childhood Program. This unique experience will provide your child with developmentally appropriate instruction in an inclusive environment with students who have been identified as having delays. This opportunity will enable your child to provide peer role modeling for developmental skills such as communication, language, and behavior skills.



Enrollment is limited in order to maintain an appropriate class size. Interested students will be invited to participate in a trial on April 29th, 2022 followed by a lottery of qualified students for selection.
