# **ATTENDANCE POLICY**



Research shows that in order for children to do well in school, they must attend school at a 95% rate.

• School day begins promptly at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 3:11 p.m.

- Please be aware that we do not allow early dismissals after 2:45 p.m.
- Every unexcused absence will result in an automated telephone call or other contact without the student's parent/guardian.
  - Students only need to stay home if they are vomiting, have diarrhea, or a fever.
    - o The health office will call you if your child becomes ill or feels worse during the day.
  - Must submit a doctor's note, or written note, within 3 days of returning to school.
- Absences may also be submitted online through the school website.
  - After the 3rd unexcused absence, the classroom teacher will call the family. You will receive
    a CCSD Attendance Letter regarding the unexcused absences. A conference may be
    scheduled to discuss absences and a plan to assist the student and the family.

## **ARRIVAL**



- The school will be OPEN at 8:35 a.m. Students MAY NOT be dropped off
   earlier than 8:35 a.m. unless they attend Safekey. Safekey opens at 7:00 a.m.
- During morning drop-off, vehicles have access to two entrances and two
  exits. Vehicles may enter through the side street and drop students off at the
  Altruismo or Reveur gate for Kiss and Go. Vehicles may park on West Torino
  Avenue and walk their child to any open gate.
- Students will immediately enter the building on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.
- Students will have morning recess on Wednesdays from 8:35 a.m. to 8:50
   a.m. Your student MUST eat breakfast first, if they choose to do so, and
- then play at recess.

















- At 3:11 p.m., students are dismissed from school
- Students will not be released for early pick up after 2:45 p.m.
- Snyder utilizes a numbered dismissal procedure. Family numbers will be used to indicate where students will be dismissed. Dismissal options include:
  - Walkers/Parents walking to pick up:
    - Isibindi Gate (off Torino Ave.) families will bring their family number for staff to enter into our system. Students will be dismissed by their teacher to the Isibindi Gate
    - Amistad Gate (bike racks)
  - Car Pick Up Altruismo Gate (car loop) Families utilizing the car loop will enter the loop off Ford Ave. and display their family number for staff to clearly see. Numbers will be entered into our system, and students will be dismissed by their teacher to that Altruismo Gate
  - o Bus students are dismissed to the courtyard and directed to the Reveur gate
  - Safekey students are dismissed from the teacher to the multipurpose room
  - At 3:18 p.m., students not picked up will be directed to the front office. You will go to the front office,
     with your ID, to check out your student





- Due to CCSD guidelines and the Department of Agriculture, food and candy are **NOT** allowed on the school campus for birthday celebrations.
- Birthday goodie bags (pencils, stickers, etc., but NO food items) may be dropped off in the front office in the morning, and the teacher can distribute them during the last ten minutes of the day.
- Balloons are not permitted for birthdays.
- Purchase your child's name on our marquee for their birthday, \$10 (cash) in the office
- Purchase school-approved snack shack for your child and their class to celebrate their birthday (purchase in the front office)




# LEARN KEY CONCEPTS

Venus has a beautiful name and is the second planet from the Sun. It's hot and has a poisonous atmosphere


















# A PICTURE ALWAYS REINFORCES THE CONCEPT

Images reveal large amounts of data, so remember: use an image instead of a long text. Your audience will appreciate it














### **PHONE MOCKUP**


